Forms to obtain a Mareva Injunction

This page contains all materials required to obtain a Mareva injunction and a Norwich order. These materials take many forms depending on the nature of the litigation.

Templates

Counsel have two alternatives when seeking a Mareva injunction and, optionally, a Norwich order. Counsel may either

- 1. prepare and issue a statement of claim, then move an urgent motion for a Mareva injunction as part of the proceeding;
- 2. prepare and issue a notice of application that seeks an interlocutory Mareva injunction and Norwich order as part of the relief sought.

All proceedings are by way of action unless otherwise allowed by the *Rules of Civil Procedure* or some other statute. An application may be filed when the facts are not likely to be controversial, or when the evidence is so clear-cut that it is unlikely that the Court will require a trial.
